CO Gear and WAI Inclusive Clothing Kit 2020 Scholarship Award

This award is designed to support a current WAI Australian chapter member with access to work clothing and safety boots designed for women to support gender inclusivity within the aviation industry.

Applicants must be a current financial member of WAI Australia and be employed or working towards a role in aviation which requires the wearing of safety boots and Cargo's.

The award will provide the following:

1 x 12-month membership to both WAI International and WAI Australia.
\$150 financial assistance towards a pair of Shewear Safety/Work Boots.
A choice of either Option A or Option B provide by Co Gear.

Option A

- 1 pair of Co Gear Sandy Functional Work Cargo Pants
- 1 pair of Co Gear Alison Hi Vis Work Cargo Pants

Option B - Maternity Clothing Kit (choose 2 items)

- 1 Co Gear Mae Hi Vis Maternity Workshirt (in Yellow/Navy)
- 1 pair of Co Gear Suzie Hi Vis Under Tummy Maternity Work Cargos Pants
- 1 pair of Co Gear Sue Hi Vis Over Tummy Maternity Work Cargos Pants

All applications must be accompanied by short essay 500 – 1000 words **maximum**. The descriptive essay should address the following:

- your aviation history and goals;
- what an inclusive Aviation Industry looks like to you

Successful applicant will be selected by the WAI Scholarships Secretary and Co Gear.

All funds will be paid directly to WAI International, WAI Australia and Shewear, or to the award recipient upon delivery of validated receipts.
