Air BP and Tristar Aviation 30 Hours Towards RPL Scholarship

This award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member to achieve 30 hours of flying towards a Recreational Pilot Licence. The flight training will be conducted by Tristar Aviation at Moorabbin Airport, Victoria.

Australian Society of Air Safety Investigators Full or Associate Membership Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member in achieving their commendable aviation endeavour in the field of Air Accident Investigation and/or Aviation Safety Management by providing a Full or Associate Membership to the Australian Society of Air Safety Investigators (ASASI). This award is aimed towards WAI Australian Chapter members who have existing experience in Aircraft Accident Investigation/Aviation Safety Management Experience who will be eligible to meet the ASASI membership requirements.

Australian Society of Air Safety Investigators Student Membership Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member in achieving their commendable aviation endeavour in the field of Air Accident Investigators and/or Aviation Safety Management by providing a Student Membership to the Australian Society of Air Safety Investigators (ASASI). The value of the scholarship provided is \$80.

Australian Aerobatic Club Membership and Aerobatic Trial Introductory Flight Membership

This award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member with a full National and State Chapter 2022 AAC membership as well as provide an aerobatic trial introductory flight to experience the thrill and challenge of competition aerobatic flight.

Australian Aviation Museum 2021 Scholarship Award

This scholarship award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member to achieve any commendable aviation endeavour by providing \$5000 of financial support towards training or for use of theory materials.

Aviation Australia Facility and Resume Coaching Scholarship Award

This scholarship is designed to assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member in achieving their aviation career goal, which is linked to a study offering by Aviation Australia. The offering a 2.5-hour facility tour and a one-on-one resume/interview coaching session.

Flightdeck Consulting Coaching and Mentoring Package Scholarship

This scholarship from Flightdeck Consulting is designed to assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member in advancing her career through a personalised one-on-one Coaching and Mentoring package. The package can be used to assist anyone who requires career mentoring, is preparing towards gaining their first job, or are preparing for an airline interview. The value of this scholarship is over \$900. The Coaching and Mentoring package will be delivered virtually, the package can be conducted anywhere in Australia.

Fly Oz Instrument Rating Exam (IREX) Theory Course Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member to undertake the Instrument Rating Exam (IREX) by providing one IREX theory course to be conducted by Fly Oz Pty Ltd in Cowra, NSW.

Fly Oz Private Pilot License (PPL) Ground Theory Course Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member to obtain a Private Pilot Licence by providing one PPL ground theory course to be conducted by Fly Oz Pty Ltd in Cowra, NSW.

Moorabbin Airport Corporation Scholarship

This scholarship award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member to achieve any commendable aviation endeavour by providing financial support towards training or for use of theory materials. The value of the scholarship is \$2500.

PanAir Flight Training Scholarship

This award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian Chapter member with fixed wing flight training costs associated with gaining any level of flying proficiency from RPL/PPL through to the CPL by providing \$2000 dollar for dollar flying training. The flight training will be conducted by PanAir Flight Training in Bathurst, NSW.

Recreation Aviation Australia's Training School Scholarship

RAAus is delighted to offer a twelve-month membership and \$1000 credit to be used with a RAAus flight training school of the recipient's choice. This scholarship can be put towards obtaining a Recreational Pilot Certificate, RAAus endorsement or RAAus instructor qualifications.

WAI Australian Chapter Scholarships

These scholarships are designed to financially assist three current WAI Australian Chapter members to achieve any commendable aviation endeavour by providing financial support towards training or for use of theory materials. Scholarship 1: \$5000, Scholarship 2: \$2500, Scholarship 3: \$2500

Our 2021 Scholarship Program is now in full swing. We now have over \$39,000 worth of scholarships to award to our members. Here is what you need to know.

So, who can apply?

Any WAI Australian Chapter current Financial Members (this includes any new financial member between now and the application closing date).

Each scholarship has slightly different eligibility and/or suitability for the application requirements, so you will have to check each application form.

Are the scholarships just for aspiring pilots?

No, some scholarships such as the Tristar Aviation and Panorama Airways Scholarships are suited specifically to someone either pursuing or looking to advance their career as a pilot, whereas the ASASI scholarship is geared towards applicants who are either qualified or interested in aviation safety.

The Australian Chapter and the Australian Aviation Museum scholarships are an open application to financially assist with the cost of aviation-related training towards any commendable aviation endeavor. This could include an aircraft maintenance engineer (AME) working towards becoming a licensed aircraft maintenance engineer (LAME), a pilot wanting to take the next step to become a flight instructor, or someone working towards an aviation management or aviation safety qualification and, of course, every aviation career in between.

When do applications close?

All applications close EOD Sunday 21st November 2021.

You still have plenty of time, but do not leave it too late!

Should you fear the application form?

Absolutely not! Applying for a scholarship may seem like a daunting process but, we promise we have made it as enjoyable as we can - for the most part, we just want to know about you and your goals.
