PanAir Flight Training Recreational or Private Pilot Licence (RPL/PPL) Scholarship Award

This award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian chapter member with fixed wing flight training costs associated with gaining flying proficiency to the level of RPL or PPL by providing \$2000 dollar for dollar flying training. The flight training will be conducted by PanAir Flight Training in Bathurst, NSW Australia. Note that the recipient will be required to arrange their own travel to and from Bathurst and any accommodation required.

All applications must be accompanied by short essay 500 – 1000 words **maximum**. The descriptive essay should address the following:

- your aviation history and goals;
- what you have done for yourself to achieve your goals;
- where you see yourself in five years;
- how the scholarship will help you achieve your objective.
