R&D AeroMed Award

This award is designed to financially assist a current WAI Australian chapter member to undertake a CASA Class 1 medical examination to be conducted by R&D AeroMed in either Sydney, Cowra or Temora, NSW. The medical includes the aviation medical examination, blood tests, hearing tests and ECG. Note that a separate ophthalmology examination (vision and eye test) is required and is not included at this stage.

About R&D AeroMed

R&D AeroMed offers a range of Aviation medical examinations. Dr Jeremy Robertson is passionate about aviation, and understands your desire to maintain your pilots licence. More than just being a representative of CASA, he feels strongly that one of the roles of a DAME is that of interpreter between the fields of medicine and aviation. Better understanding on both sides fosters a positive working relationship with the mutual goal of keeping you flying safely.

Prior to training as a doctor, Dr Robertson had a twelve year career as a commercial pilot, where he worked as a flying instructor, charter pilot and international airline pilot. During this period he lost his class 1 medical on two separate occasions, the second time permanently (hence the career change!). He remains actively involved in general aviation, flying regularly for a local skydive company, and flying himself out to Temora and Cowra once a month to perform aviation medicals.

All applications must be accompanied by a short statement 250 words **maximum**. The statement should address the following:

- your aviation history and goals;
- what you have done for yourself to achieve your goals;
- how the scholarship will help you achieve your objective.
