Selection Criteria Awards will be judged against the following criteria:

- Demonstrated effectiveness as an individual, or as part of a team, in relation to WAI Australia
- Demonstrated ability to inspire others in relation to volunteering within the WAI Australian chapter
- Demonstrated reliability, positivity, flexibility and collaborative initiative
- Championing a cause to raise awareness or funds for particular chapter events

The judging panel for the award will include the Australian Chapter National President and the Scholarship Stakeholders Committee.

The Award will be presented annually in line with the chapter scholarship program.
